

Macbeth Presentation - EAE3U

Your task is to present a monologue or an important *dialogue from Shakespeare's *Macbeth*.

- Have your part approved before you start to memorize lines
- Let your teacher know in advance when you are ready to present. (At least one day before.)
- You must present before the exam review week in June.
- Have a print-out of your lines (handed in to your teacher on the day you present)
- Choose an audience member that will follow your print-out during your presentation – this person can “feed” lines or words if needed.
- If you start presenting and you mess up, you can start over once without penalty

Criteria:

- Memorize your lines
- Deliver your lines with intention and understanding
- Vary your tone of voice
- Acknowledge your audience
- Be creative - costume, props, music...
- It must be obvious that you have practiced

This is the only evaluation on Macbeth other than the questions that will be on the Exam.
