## **Research Report:**

## **Simple Steps to Writing**

#### Introduction:

- 1. General comment to grab the reader's attention (1 sentence).
- 2. Describe the subject/topic with more precision (1 to 2 sentences).
- 3. Explain the goal of your research (1 to 2 sentences).

# Body (4 paragraphs)

- 1. What is your initial product? How is taken from its natural resource?
- 2. How is the resource transformed into a product?
- 3. Explain how the final product is transported and sold.
- 4. Describe the use of technology throughout the process.

#### Conclusion

- 1. Write a summary of the research report.
- 2. Reflect upon the process. Is it interesting? Does it include a job that would interest you? What was surprising to learn?

You must refer to the handout: Writing a Structured Paragraph AND MLA Format.

#### **Presentation:**

- 1. Use point-form information.
- 2. Use visuals: pictures and videos (ex: YouTube How it's Made)
- 3. Explain all the steps of the resource to product transformation. Make sure to acknowledge your audience and have a good tone of voice.
- 4. Make sure that you are presenting your topic in a logical order.
- 5. Use appropriate vocabulary for the topic presented.
